

Winifred Gales

(12 Jul 1761 – 26 Jun 1839)

The National Intelligencer, June 27, 1839

Died. Yesterday afternoon, in the 79th year of her age, after a painful illness of several months' duration, Mrs. Winifred Gales, consort of Joseph Gales, Esq., of this city, (late of North Carolina,) and mother of one of the Editors of the National Intelligencer, of the wife of the other Editor of that journal, and of the junior Editor of the Raleigh Register. She was a native of Newark, in England, and emigrated to this country with her surviving husband and her then living children in the year 1795 resided in Philadelphia until 1799, and the remainder of the intervening time, except the last six years, in North Carolina.

Funeral service will take place at the Unitarian Church, at half past 4 o'clock this afternoon at which her friends and acquaintances, and those of the families of J. Gales, Jr. and W.W. Seaton, are respectfully invited to attend.
