Galt. On Monday morning, November 22, 1886 at 2:00 a.m., Captain Jacob Galt in the 80th year of his age. Funeral from the residence of Mr. William Galt, 720 9th Street, N.W., Tuesday afternoon at two o'clock. Friends of the family invited to attend.

Death of Captain Galt.

Captain Jacob Galt died at an early hour this morning. He was in early life a shipmaster and for many years sailed out of the port of Alexandria, Va. at which place he was born in 1806. He retired from active life many years ago and has resided in this city ever since. Captain Galt was a half brother of the Messrs. Galt, jewelers. He will be buried from the residence of Mr. William Galt, 720 9th street tomorrow afternoon at 2 o'clock.

Washington Evening Star, November 23, 1880

The funeral of the late Captain Galt took place this afternoon from the residence of his brother, No. 720 9th street, N.W. Six of the nephews of the deceased acted as pallbearers. They were Frank Galt, Harry E. Davis, Hunter Galt, Charles E. Galt, Norman Galt and William W. Galt. The interment was in Congressional Cemetery.
