Miss Helen Gardner, 80, Native of Washington, Dies

Miss Helen Wilson Gardner, 80, a native of Washington and member of one of the city's oldest families, died July 10, in Oakland, Calif., relatives here learned today.

She was the granddaughter of Col. Charles K. Gardner, early Washington resident who at one time was adjutant general of the Army and assistant Postmaster General. Miss Gardner was one of the first women to graduate from the Garfield Hospital nurses' training school.

About 20 years ago, Miss Gardner left Washington to live with friends in Oakland.

Her only immediate survivor is a sister, Miss Almy Gardner of 1221 Massachusetts avenue N.W. Her body will be brought here for burial later.
