**Drowned.** Yesterday afternoon a youth of 8 or 9 years named Edward Garner jr. was drowned at the canal locks between this city and Georgetown. He had gone to that part of the city on a visit to his uncle, and on his way accidentally fell into the canal and was drowned before assistance could reach him. His body was recovered after some lapse of time and was taken to the residence of his distressed parents, corner of F and 10th sts., Island.
