Drowned in the Potomac

The steamer *George Leary* brought to this city this morning the remains of Edward Gibson, a young man who lived at 419 12th street southwest and who was drowned in the Potomac on the border of St. Mary's co., Md., yesterday morning by his fishing boat being swamped. Undertaker Lee prepared his remains for burial and removed them to his parents' home.
