Death of a Police Matron

Mrs. Edith Gingell, matron of the sixth police station, died Saturday night at her home, No. 621 9th street northeast, of cancer of the throat. Her husband was killed on the railroad about ten years ago, and in 1889 she was appointed police matron. Mrs. Gingell was a native of England, but had lived in this country many years.
