Mrs. Marie G. Goddard Dead

Native of Maryland and Longtime Washington Resident

Mrs. Marie Goldsborough Goddard, a long-time resident of Washington, died in her eighty-seventh year, yesterday morning in her apartments in the Madrid. Funeral services are to be conducted tomorrow morning at 9:30 o'clock at St. Matthew's Catholic Church. Interment is to be in Congressional cemetery.

Mrs. Goddard was born in Montgomery county, Md., and was educated in the Georgetown Convent in this city. She had been an honorary president of the alumni association of the convent up until the time of her death. Just before the death of her husband, Andrew Goddard, which occurred about a year ago, Mrs. Goddard celebrated her sixty-fifth wedding anniversary.

She is survived by a son, Goldsborough Goddard, and a daughter, Miss Mary Lee Goddard.
