## Miss Mary Goddard Dies, Headed Convent Alumnae

Miss Mary Lee Goddard, 83, honorary president of the Georgetown Visitation Convent Alumnae Association for many years and a lifelong District resident, died last night after an illness of five months. She lived at 2300 Eighteenth street N.W.

Born on nearby Maryland farm a few weeks after the Confederate surrender at Appomattox, Miss Goddard was the daughter of Andrew Goddard, prominent Washington businessman in the post-Civil War era and Maria Goldsborough Goddard.

Active in patriotic societies, she was a member of Manor House Chapter of the DAR and of the Colonial Dames of Maryland.

She was a Patent Office employe for nearly 50 years, retiring 18 years ago.

Requiem mass will be said for Miss Goddard at 9 a.m. Tuesday in St. Matthew's Cathedral. Burial will be in Congressional Cemetery.
