After an illness of only twenty-four hours, Mr. Steven M. Golden, a well-known resident of the District, died last night at his residence on Maple avenue, in Anacostia. Early in the day yesterday Mr. Golden became ill, and had a severe hemorrhage. This occurred in the city, but he was removed to his home, where he died during the night. Deceased came to the vicinity of Anacostia in 1859, and purchased a large tract of land, known now as the Havemeyer property. For ten years, commencing a year or two before the war, he was superintendent of roads, after which he conducted a large dairying business. Mr. Golden was a Mason of high degree, and a member of Anacostia Lodge. A short time ago he sold his property and removed to Anacostia. He leaves a wife and daughter, and a son. The funeral will take place on Saturday.
