Veteran Printer and Fireman Was Eighty Years Old

John A. Goodrick, eighty years old, veteran printer and veteran fireman, an employe of the government printing office since 1863, died this morning at his home, 443 6th street southwest, of heart disease, following an illness of several months.

Funeral services are to be held Wednesday afternoon at 3 o'clock at Lee's undertaking establishment. Interment is to be at Congressional cemetery. Members of Columbia Typographical Union, No. 101, of which Mr. Goodrick was a charter member, and of the jobroom, of the government printing office will attend the services.
