Death Wins In Race

Infant of R.M Gordon Dies in Hurried Trip to City

Virginia May Gordon, two months old, child of Robert M. Gordon, 1218 D street southeast, died yesterday afternoon while being brought home from Colonial Beach for medical treatment. Mrs. Martha Jane Gordon, the child's mother, died shortly after the daughter's birth, and Mrs. Kate Glbson, mother of Mrs. Gordon, took the little one to Colonial Beach several days ago.

The infant was taken ill while at the resort, and a physician who attended her told the grandmother she probably would not recover. Mrs. Gibson, anxious to do everything possible for the patient, hurried across the river and started home on a motor bus. Trouble with the vehicle caused a delay on the homeward journey, and the child died before reaching here. A certificate of death from natural causes was given.
