Mrs. Sarah Graham, a venerable and much respected lady, died at the residence of her son, near Arlington, Virginia at the ripe age of eighty seven and her funeral took place last Wednesday. All that affection could prompt to make her last days peaceful was done by her family. The funeral service was conducted by Rev. Dr. Riddle, of Falls Church, and her remains, encased in a walnut coffin, heavily mounted with silver were buried in the family lot in Congressional Cemetery. Mrs. Graham was the mother of Curtis Graham and John R. Graham, well-known citizens of Washington, and the aunt of Rear Admiral Worden, U.S.N., who, with his wife, attended the funeral.
