Miss Helen Gray, Music Teacher

Miss Helen Mabel Gray, 83, a former piano teacher and a retired Government employe, died Saturday at the National Presbyterian Home for the Aged, 3050 Military road N.W., where she had lived for 11 years.

A third-generation Washingtonian, Mrs. Gray was born within sight of the Capitol. She taught piano for many years until a heart condition forced her to give it up.

During World War II, when she was in her sixties, she joined the staff of the Adjutant General's office.

She was a member of Capitol Hill Presbyterian Church.

In recent years, she had given piano lessons to her adopted daughter, Mrs. Jo Foley, who survives her at 5137 Crisfield drive S.E.

Services will be at 10 a.m. tomorrow at the National Presbyterian Home. Burial will be in the family plot in Congressional Cemetery.
