At two o'clock this morning, a girl, named Virginia Gray, was found in a dying condition at house No. 501 13th street, near C, and she expired soon after. Coroner Woodward held an inquest, and the jury rendered a verdict, "That the deceased came to the house, No. 501 13th street, about one week from this day, and on the 25th she took opium at four o'clock and laudanum at seven o'clock the same day, and the jury believe she came to her death from the free use of opium and laudanum, and that she has no property and no effects."
