'Toy' Pistol Killing Declared Accident

Coroner A. Magruder MacDonald yesterday issued a certificate of accidental death in the shooting Sunday of William H. Green, 54, 645 Morton place northeast.

Green was killed by a bullet fired by a friend, Peter Boyer, 65, warehouse watchman, who mistook his revolver for a toy pistol.

Dr. MacDonald said police investigation showed clearly the shooting was accidental, adding the toy gun and revolver were of about the same size and appearance.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. tomorrow at Lee's funeral home, Fourth street and Massachusetts avenue northeast. Burial will be in Congressional Cemetery.
