Samuel Grimes' Sudden Death

Samuel H. Grimes died suddenly yesterday about 2:30 o'clock p.m. at his residence, No. 107 Harrison street, Anacostia. Earlier in the day Dr. R.A. Pyles had made arrangements for the man's removal to one of the city hospitals, and it was while awaiting the arrival of the ambulance ordered for this purpose that death ensued. Several days ago similar preparations had been effected by the doctor in the case, but at that time, too, Mr. Grimes became so ill before the ambulance reached the house that his transfer to the hospital had to be deferred. It was apparent that he dreaded and brooded over what he conceived to be a severe ordeal in becoming a patient in a hospital. Heart disease was named as the cause of his death. The deceased was about thirty-seven years old and is survived by a wife and two small children.
