Sudden Death

Olaf Guerdrum, Post Office Department Draftsman, Passes Away

Olaf W. Guerdrum, a draftsman employed in the Post Office Department died suddenly yesterday morning while in bed at his residence, No. 440 Jefferson street, Anacostia, from angina pectoris. Mr. Guerdrum had remained away from his office Wednesday on account of an attack of illness. Thursday, after receiving medical attention, he recovered sufficiently to walk about, and retired at night feeling about as well as usual. His wife was horrified in the morning by the discovery that he was dead. Two physicians had been in attendance and a certificate of death from natural causes was given.

Mr. Guerdrum was fifty-four years of age and was a native of Norway. His wife and four daughters and a son survive him. His funeral will be private and will take place tomorrow from his late home. The burial will be made at a local cemetery.
