Dorothy Gunion Feared Long Sickness Through Nervous Breakdown

In ill health and fearing a nervous breakdown, Miss Dorothy Gunion, 1717 T street, last evening ended her life with illuminating gas in a bathroom at her home. Her mother found her body shortly before 7 o'clock and reported the incident to the coroner.

Miss Gunion, who was twenty-five years old, left a note, in which she informed her parents that she preferred death to a long sickness. Coroner Nevitt gave a certificate of suicide.
