### **George Handy Dies; Kin of Matthew Brady**

George M. Handy, 67, great nephew of Matthew B. Brady, photographer of Abraham Lincoln and many Civil War battlefields, died Friday at a hospital here. He had been in ill health for several years.

Mr. Handy was a switch conductor at the Washington Terminal for 20 years until his retirement two years ago. He previously had worked as a fireman on the Pennsylvania Railroad lines operating out of Washington, and as a brakeman at the terminal.

He was a native of the District. For many years he lived at the family home at 494 Maryland avenue S.W. There, an uncle, Levin Handy, who was Mr. Brady's nephew, owned and operated a photographic studio with Mr. Brady.

In recent years, Mr. Handy lived at 917 Fourth street N.E. with his wife, the former Margaret J. Mehl, whom he married in 1903. They had no children.

Mr. Handy leaves, in addition to his widow, two sisters, Mrs. Nina Merryman and Mrs. Rose Osterman, and three brothers, Samuel, Edward and Millard Handy, all of Washington.

Funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. Tuesday at the Lee Funeral Home, Fourth street and Massachusetts avenue N.E. Burial will be in Congressional Cemetery.
