Dr. C.E. Hawks, county medical examiner, issued a certificate of suicide.

Carroll Bledsoe, another roomer, forced open the door of Mr. Hardy's room after smelling gas, police said. The Bethesda Rescue Squad administered artificial respiration for nearly an hour without success. Funeral arrangements had not been completed today.
