

Rev. F.L. Hayes Dies

Was Prominent in Congregational Ministerial Relief Work



Chicago, April 3 -- The Rev. Francis L. Hayes, western secretary of the Congregational Board of Ministerial Relief died at his Oak Park home last night. Death was caused by influenza and bronchitis.

He was born January 5, 1858 at Hampton, N.H. and was ordained in the Free Baptist Ministry in 1885. His pastorate was the First Christian Church of Boston. Later changes included churches in Manitou, Col.; Topeka, Kans. and Chicago.
