Mrs. Lillian Wooldridge Hazard, 75, of 1210 Holbrook terrace N.E., a resident of the Washington area for about 40 years, died yesterday in the home of a daughter, Mrs. John C. Ropes, in Stratford, Conn.

Mrs. Hazard had been ill for two months. She was returning from Rockport, Mass., where she and her husband, Elmont B. Hazard, a retired attorney have a summer home.

Mrs. Hazard was born in Cornwall, England, and came to the United States when she was 3. She was educated in Boston and lived in the Washington area since 1909. For about 20 years she resided in Chevy Chase, Md., where she was active in church work.

In addition to her husband and daughter, Mrs. Hazard is survived by another daughter, Miss Charlotte W. Hazard, who is with the International Provisional Frequency Board in Geneva, Switzerland, and a son, John W. Hazard, of Arlington, Va., an associate editor for Kiplinger Magazine.
