Jeffrey A. Heiners, 36, a field producer and photographer-editor for Gannett News Service/Television in the Washington area, died of a heart attack October 8 at Capitol Hill Hospital.

Mr. Heiners, a resident of Washington since moving here in 1979 was born in Milwaukee. He was a graduate of the Milwaukee Area Technical College. He worked for the American Broadcast News and Docuvid before joining Gannett in 1984.

His assignments included the 1984 and 1988 national political campaigns, several space shuttle launchings, the 1988 Winter Olympics in Calgary, Alberta, and the Loma Prieta earthquake in California in 1989.

Survivors include his parents, Lorna and Walter Heiners, and two sisters, Judith Fink and Jean Kremer, all of Milwaukee.
