Dies Of His Injuries

Raymond Henderson, Whose Neck Was Broken, Succumbs In Hospital

Raymond Henderson, 105-1/2 Benning road northeast, whose neck was broken as a result of diving in shallow water at Chesapeake Beach Wednesday afternoon died at Casualty Hospital yesterday afternoon, nearly twenty-four hours after he was injured. Coroner Nevitt viewed the body at the morgue, heard statements of the affair and gave a certificate of accidental death.

Henderson, who was employed as a craneman at the plant of the Washington Steel and Ordnance Company is survived by his wife and one child. Funeral services will be held at his late home at 2 o'clock tomorrow afternoon. Interment will be in Congressional cemetery.
