Mrs. Mary C. Hendley, 91, widow of Charles M. Hendley, a secretary to President Grover Cleveland, died Friday at her home, 2022 Columbia road N.W.

Mrs. Hendley, a native of Port Deposit, Md., came to Washington early in her life and remained in the area until her death.

Prior to World War I Mrs. Hendley traveled around the world with her husband. He later wrote a book about their trip entitled "The Trifles of Travel."

Mrs. Hendley was a member of the Washington Club, the Chevy Chase Club and the Woman Geographers.

She leaves two sisters, Mrs. Sara Johnson of Front Royal, Va., and Mrs. J.P.F. Miller of Bealeton, Va.
