Dr. G.N. Henning Dies; GW Professor Emeritus

Dr. George Neely Henning, 79, professor emeritus of George Washington University and a well known author and editor of French literature, died yesterday at his home, 3720 McKinley street N.W.

A native of Washington, Dr. Henning was the son of George Custis and Susannah Neely Henning. He received his master's degree from Harvard in 1898 and his doctor's degree from George Washington University in 1919.

He was an instructor in French at Columbian College, now George Washington University, from 1894 to 1897. From 1901 to 1939, Dr. Henning was a professor of Romance languages at George Washington, and was dean of the School of Graduate Studies from 1919 to 1931.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Tuesday at the Joseph Gawler's & Sons funeral home, 1756 Pennsylvania avenue N.W. Burial will be in the Congressional Cemetery.
