Two Well-Known Citizens Dead

Mr. Lemuel H. Henry died Saturday at his residence, 1136 7th street, aged 60 years. Mr. Henry was a native of this city and in ante bellum days was well known as a volunteer fireman and local politician, and for many years filled a position in the Treasury department. Since the war he had been a clerk with Harvey, Clarke & Given, and latterly with Mr. John T. Given, but about a year since his health failed him. His funeral took place this afternoon. Mr. Henry was prominent as an Odd Fellow and Mason.
