### **Mrs. J.C. Hesse Dies**

#### **Funeral Services Will Be Held Saturday Afternoon**

Mrs. Marie Victoria Hesse, wife of John C. Hesse, for many years chief of a division in the War Department, died at the family residence, 506 A street southeast, early this morning. She was in her seventy-ninth year and had been married fifty-eight years.

Mrs. Hesse was a native of New York city. She is survived by her husband and two sons, Henry A. Hesse, chief of the examining division, Civil Service Commission, and Edwin B. Hesse, chief clerk of the police department.

Funeral services will be held at her late home at 2 o'clock Saturday afternoon. Rev. John Weidley, pastor of the Church of the Reformation, will officiate, and interment will be in Congressional cemetery.
