Dies of Her Burns

Miss Lydia J. Hinson Succumbs in Sibley Hospital

Miss Lydia J. Hinson, who was burned in her office at 1205 New Jersey avenue northwest Friday, died of her injuries at 6 o'clock this morning at Sibley Hospital. Arrangements for the funeral have not been completed.

Miss Hinson was the daughter of the late L.F. and E.E. Hinson. She was born in Portsmouth, Va., and came to Washington when a young girl.

Miss Hinson was in her office Friday when her clothing struck against a stove and ignited. Within a few seconds she was enveloped in flames and before they could be extinguished she was burned about the upper part of the body. She was taken to Sibley Hospital, where her condition became gradually worse.
