In February 1972, the ashes of Winston Ellis Hobbs were interred in site 186. He was the son of Hermann and Ethel Lancaster Hobbs, was born in Linden, Md., March 1, 1912, graduated from Central High School, Washington, D.C., Dartmouth College Phi Beta Kappa, attended Cornell University Law School, graduated from George Washington University Law School and was a member of the D.C. and New York bars.

He served in the U.S. Navy during World War II and attained the rank of Lt. Cmdr. His professional career was with the Corporation Trust Company in Washington, D.C. and New York City, where he held the position of Senior Vice President at the time of his death from cancer. He was 59 years old. He was married to Emily Knight Ritter on June 11, 1938 at All Souls Episcopal Church, Washington, D.C. He was the father of David Ellis, Dorothy Evelyn and Frederick Gilbert Hobbs.
