#### **Widow of Police Captain Succumbs at Age of Sixty**

After a long illness Mrs. Capitola Virginia Hollinberger, widow of Capt. J.T. Hollinberger of the metropolitan police force, died at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Benjamin B. Delaney, 123 Tennessee avenue northeast, last night. Mrs. Hollinberger was sixty years old.
