Death of George T. Howard

Mr. George T. Howard, who has been District weigher for two years past, died suddenly yesterday afternoon. He was taken very ill in the street, and was carried to his home, 206 6th street northeast, where he died in about five minutes, having spoken only once or twice after being stricken. He was a native of this city and unusually popular. He seemed to be in the best of health, and his death is a great shock to his family and friends. He leaves a widow and five children. One of his sons, Robert Howard, is assistant secretary of the Franklin Insurance Company. Mr. Clement Howard, a brother of the deceased, is secretary of the Fireman's Insurance Company.
