The body of this unfortunate man, who was drowned the first of the winter, while attempting to swim from his boat (which had sunk off the Arsenal) to the shore, was found washed ashore at Geesboro' Point yesterday. The remains, which were only to be identified by the clothing, were boxed up and conveyed to his widow's residence, near the Smithsonian Institution.
