Funeral Services Tomorrow for District Native

Charles H. Hunt, 55 years old, salesman for the Texas Oil Co. and a life-long resident of this city, died here yesterday after an illness of about five months. He was a member of the Washington Board of Trade and of the United Commercial Travelers' Association.
