Mrs. Hutchinson, Author of Short Stories, Dies

Mrs. Marguerite J. Hutchinson, 48, of 604 Van Buren street N.W., died yesterday at Garfield Memorial Hospital.

A native of Washington, Mrs. Hutchinson attended George Washington University. For the last 15 years, until ill health forced her resignation four months ago, she had been employed in the Children's Bureau of the Labor Department.

She was the author of several short stories that had been published in women's magazines and was working on a book about the experiences of a combat pilot during the war.

Mrs. Hutchinson was a member of the Daughters of the American Revolution and of the Fourth Presbyterian Church.

Surviving are three sons, John L., William D. and Robert A. Hutchinson; her mother, Mrs. William E. Saunders, and a grandson, all of Washington, and a brother, Arthur T. Saunders, Tulsa, Okla.

Funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. tomorrow at Hines funeral home, 2901 Fourteenth street N.W. Burial will be in Congressional Cemetery.
