Obituary

Last Wednesday [June 22] the remains of the late Jacob D. Hutton, an old and respected citizen, were taken from the vault and interred in Congressional Cemetery, in the presence of relatives and friends. Deceased was born in Baltimore in 1830, but for the last thirty years has resided in this city, where he at one time conducted a large contracting business. He was a member of Hamline M.E. church, and an ardent and consistent Christian, also a Mason of prominence.
