Rev. E.H. Ingle Dies

Assistant Pastor of Epiphany Episcopal Church Succumbs

Rev. Edward H Ingle, assistant pastor of Epiphany Episcopal Church and chaplain of the Epiphany Church Home, died yesterday at Emergency Hospital of pneumonia, following a short illness. He was eighty-one years old and had been a resident of Washington all his life, having been born here.

Dr. Ingle resided at the Hotel Conald. His closest relatives are a niece and nephew, not of this city. He had been connected with the Epiphany Church for about ten years.

Funeral services will be held tomorrow afternoon at 2:30 o'clock at Epiphany Church, G street between 13th and 14th streets. Interment will be in Congressional cemetery.

Chaplain of Epiphany Church Home to Be Buried Tomorrow

Funeral services for the Rev. Dr. Edward H. Ingle, chaplain of the Epiphany Church Home an assistant minister at the Church of the Epiphany, who died at Emergency Hospital yesterday morning, will be held tomorrow afternoon at 2:30 o'clock at the Church of the Epiphany. Interment will be private.

Dr. Ingle had been in the hospital for about a week at the time of his death. He was 82 years of age and had been in failing health for some time. He had been attached to the clergy of the Epiphany Church for about ten years. Several nephews and nieces survive him.
