Fireman Jenkins Killed

Edward Jenkins, who for many years had been fireman at the Adams building, on F street northwest, was killed by a Baltimore and Ohio train while walking on the tracks at Montello, near Ivy City, early yesterday morning. The body was first taken to the morgue, where it was viewed by Coroner Carr, after which it was removed to the home of Jenkins' brother-in-law, Policeman Thomas Markward, at Langdon, with whom Jenkins had lived. The coroner decided that an inquest was unnecessary, as it was, in his opinion, clearly the man's own fault that he met his death.
