A Boy Drowned

The remains of Johnnie Jenkins, a fourteen-year-old son of Mrs. A. Jenkins, who resides at 231 10th street southeast, were brought to this city last night by the steamer Harry Randall from Colonial Beach. The lad was in Monroe's creek at the latter place last Saturday, and getting beyond his depth, was drowned, being unable to swim. The body was recovered early yesterday morning.
