Mrs. A.W. Johnson Dies

Widow of Physician Was Native of Maryland

Mrs. Annie W. Johnson, well known in this city, where she had resided the greater part of her life, died October 1 at Colonial Beach. Mrs. Johnson was the widow of the late Dr. A.E. Johnson, well known as a physician, and for many years a surgeon of Lincoln Post, G.A.R., and surgeon general of the national organization.

Mrs. Johnson was a native of Maryland. She was a member of the Phil Sheridan Woman's Relief Corps, Department of the Potomac, and an active worker in other patriotic organizations. In 1896 she was departmental president and a member of the national department of the Woman's Relief Corps. She was an honorary member of the Old Guard.

Mrs. Johnson is survived by six daughters--Mrs. Julius F. Nagle, Mrs. J.W. Pfeiger, Philadelphia; Mrs. Frank T. Tennyson, Rochester; Mrs. Robert T. Boardman and Mrs. Lydia J. Cox and Mrs. John W. Fenton of this city, all of whom were with her at the time of her death.

The funeral services were held from the home of Mrs. John W. Fenton, 1474 Meridien place, this afternoon. Interment was in Congressional cemetery.
