### **George V. Johnson Dies**

#### **Washington Resident Succumbs to Influenza at Sanitarium**

George Vincent Johnson of 1813 M street, a news writer, died suddenly last night, at Washington Sanitarium of Spanish influenza. Mr. Johnson was taken ill five days ago and had been unconscious since Thursday. Funeral arrangements will be announced later.

Mr. Johnson was at one time connected with the police department as a photographer. He also contributed special articles to Washington newspapers several years ago.

Until two weeks ago he had been employed in the Department of Labor in Baltimore. At that time he entered the service of the International News Service here, covering the Treasury Department, when he was stricken.

He is survived by his wife, Adele Johnson; two sons, James and William, and three sisters.
