**Johnson.** Yesterday morning after a short but painful illness, Professor Walter R. Johnson, aged 57 years. The funeral will take place on Wednesday morning at 10 o'clock from his late residence on 12th street near E. The friends of the family are invited to attend.

At a meeting of the National Institute, held yesterday afternoon at the office of the Corresponding Secretary, (J.C.G.. Kennedy,) the following resolutions were unanimously adopted:

Resolved, That we have heard with deep regret of the decease of Prof. Walter R. Johnson, late a member and for some years the Corresponding Secretary of the National Institute.

Resolved, That we entertain a grateful sense of services of Prof. Johnson as a member and officer of this institution, and a high appreciation of his private virtues as well as his scientific character and labors.

Resolved, That we respectfully tender to the family of the deceased the expression of our sincere sympathy in their bereavement.

Resolved, That as a token of our respect for the deceased we will attend his funeral, and wear the usual badge of mourning.

Ordered, That these resolutions, signed by the President and Secretary, be published in the Washington papers, and a copy of them transmitted to the family of the deceased.
