Wife Indicted In Slaying Of Student

A 25-year-old woman was indicted yesterday in District Court on a charge of murdering her estranged husband, Howard University Medical School senior Henry K. Karissa.

Karissa, 29, of 429 Brandywine st. se., was a citizen of Kenya and had been married to his Chicago-born wife about four years when he was killed on August 23.

Police reported finding him at his home with seven bullets in his body and neck. They said the shooting followed a dispute.

A semi-automatic pistol and nine expended shells were recovered in the home. Mrs. Karissa was charged with first degree murder.
