Wife Killed; Husband Hurt

Body of Mrs. Charles Kibbey Brought From Danville, Pa.

Mrs. Charles Kibbey of 433 New Jersey avenue southeast was killed in an automobile accident at Lewisburg, Pa., last Friday, and the body was brought to the home here last night. Her husband, who was driving a new car from Buffalo, had three ribs and his jaw broken, and lies in a hospital at Danville. He does not know that his wife is dead.

It is understood that the car was struck by a traction car and Mrs. Kibbey thrown from the back seat and killed instantly. Mrs. Barnes, a sister of the deceased, was severely hurt.
