Coroner's Verdict in Case of Mrs. King, Fatally Burned

Coroner Nevitt gave a certificate of accidental death in the case of Mrs. Laura Ethel King, 24, wife of William R. King, member of No. 14 engine company, who was fatally burned yesterday morning when her dress ignited from a fire in a stove at the family home, 1052 Bladensburg road northeast. Funeral services will be held Monday afternoon at 2 o'clock in Nazarene Church, 1202 Bladensburg road. Interment will be in Congressional Cemetery.
