Robert E. Lammond, 66, vice president of the District Realty Title Insurance Corp., died Wednesday after a heart attack at his home, 2500 Q st. nw.



A native Washingtonian, Mr. Lammond graduated from Central High School and St. John's College. He was a Senate page during the administration of Woodrow Wilson.

In 1922 he became a stock broker with the W.B. Hibbs Co., and two years later he joined the Columbia Real Estate Title Insurance Co., which made him vice president in 1963. He left the company in December, 1965, to join District-Realty.

Mr. Lammond was treasurer of the District of Columbia Land Title Association and an active member of the Washington Board of Trade and the Washington Board of Realtors.

He is survived by his wife, Marguerite; two sisters, Anne and Henrietta Lammond, of Washington, and two brothers, Willoughby, of Arlington, and Addison, of Washington.
