Services Over Remains at Residence of Her Daughter-in-Law

Funeral services over the remains of Mrs. Ann Margaret Larner, who died Thursday afternoon, were held at 2 o'clock today at the residence of her daughter-in-law, Mrs. Annie C. Larner, 926 Massachusetts avenue northwest, Rev. Dr. J.G. Butler of Vermont Avenue Lutheran Memorial Church officiated.
