Death of E.H. Larrabee

E.H. Larrabee died yesterday after a long and painful illness from heart trouble and other complications incident to his hard service in the late war. He served faithfully in company F, first Connecticut heavy artillery. He was an efficient officer on the police force for twenty-three years, and was then retired and pensioned. He leaves a widow, who has the sympathy of a large circle of friends. Mr. Larrabee was fifty-seven years of age. His funeral will take place under the auspices of Lincoln Post, G.A.R., at 4:30 p.m. tomorrow, from his late residence, 19 K street northwest. Interment will be at Rock Creek cemetery.
