Ill On Street; Dies

Edgar G. Leapley Sought by Family After Death Occurs

Edgar G. Leapley, sixty-eight years old, left his home at 2223 Nichols avenue, Anacostia, early last night and his failure to return home at a late hour so greatly alarmed his daughters that they asked the police to find him. Three hours before the request was made, however, the reported missing man had died at 112 D street. He had been taken sick on the street and gone to the D street address where he died about 11 o'clock. It was about 2 o'clock this morning when relatives asked the police of the eleventh precinct to find him. Dr. William B. Carr, acting coroner, gave a certificate of death from heart disease.
