William Leonhardt Dead At Age of 65

Pioneer Electrical Contractor Had Been Life-Long Resident of Capital

Frederick William Leonhardt, 65 years old, for more than 40 years an electrical contractor and one of the pioneers in that business here, died at his residence, 1615 East Capitol street, Saturday. He had been ill a week

A lifelong resident of Washington, Mr. Leonhardt conducted the electrical business bearing his name at 1108 New York avenue for about 35 years. He was president of the council of St. Mark's Lutheran Church, Eighth and H streets southwest, and was active in church work.

One son, Carl H Leonhardt; two daughters, Mrs. Florence M. Lippard and Mrs. Eleanor Flint, all of Washington, and one sister, Miss Margaret Leonhardt, Brentwood survive.

Funeral services were held this afternoon in St. Mark's Lutheran Church, conducted by the pastor, Rev. H. Dennington Hays. Interment was in Congressional Cemetery.
